

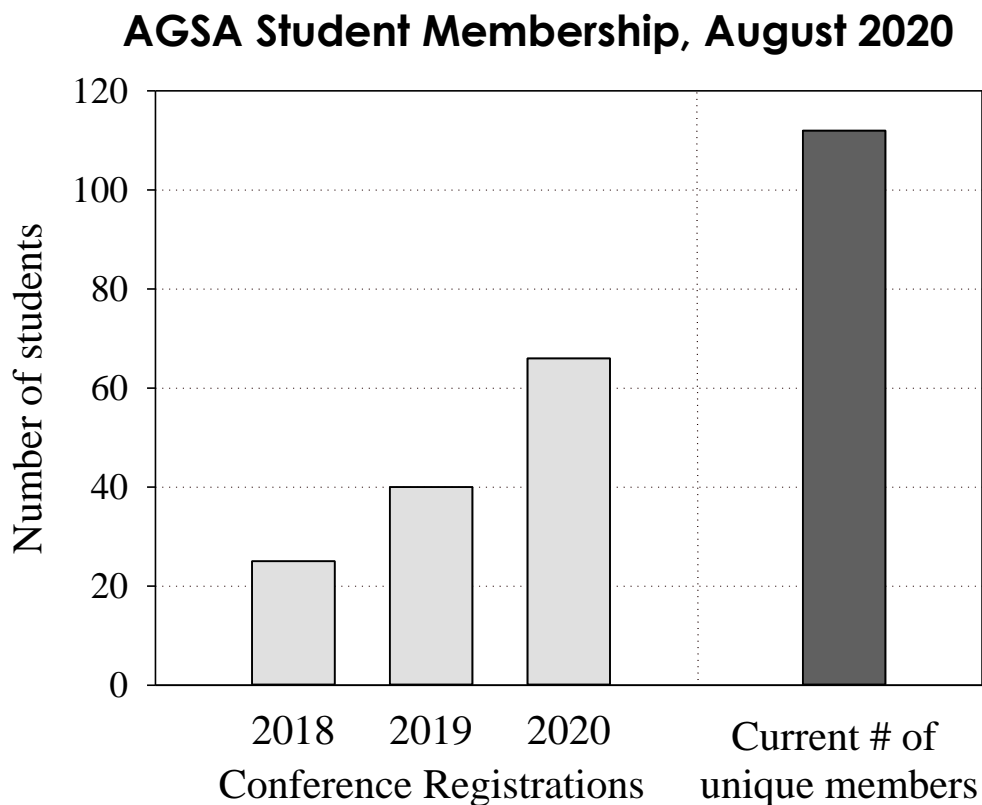


**Student Activities Report**  
**Annual General Meeting, 27<sup>th</sup> August, 2020**  
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**1. AGSA student registrations for 2020 conference and total student membership**

The number of student registrations for the 2020 online AGSA conference was 66, which is higher than student registrations for conferences that were held in 2018 (25) and 2019 (40) – see attached figure.

The total number of unique AGSA members on the current student mailing list is 113, which includes conference registrants from 2018, 2019 and 2020 (excluding duplications).



In 2020, we have seen an increase in student membership from non-traditional AGSA organisations within Australia (e.g. Monash University, Swinburne University of Technology) and from non-Australasian countries (e.g. Philippines, China, Pakistan, Nepal).
